

#### **7.2.4.2. Housing: Field Survey**

Rajaborari is the tribal area and the maximum part of the village is covered by forest. Due to lack of capital the villagers are surviving their life in self prepared Raw houses (hut or tapper in local language). Dayalbagh society wanted to develop this village, so RSS Sabha constructed a colony in Rajaborari with permanent houses. Villagers prepare their hut through soil, woods, cow dung, bamboo, splinter of bamboos etc. These raw materials are normally available in village so villagers are used to it.

In Rajaborari, almost all the houses (hatched huts) are made from soil, wood, cow dunk, bamboo, splinter of bamboos etc.
