

## Field Survey

In Rajaborari village, the main employment is agriculture. Maximum number of families depend on the agriculture income. Some people gain income from own agriculture land and some people gain from working as labour in agriculture activity. No any formal industry is established in Rajaborari village.

Some small (kirana shop) shops and motor/cycle repairing shops are running at Rajaborari. It is also the employment source to the poor villagers for regular income.

### Local plants use for business purpose:

Names of plants are sagoun, khakra, tentupatta, bamboo, Neem

Plant	Features/Uses
Sagoun	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Wood of sagoun is very costly, qualities of woods are: strong wood, high shining</li><li>• Use in furniture, housing and decoration</li><li>• Planting in rainy season (June-august)</li><li>• Total no of plants is recorded by the government through marsh, villagers do not use this plant for personal purpose</li><li>• Forest department sales the plant outside the village and income from the sale is used for the development of village</li><li>• Market value of this plant is very high</li></ul>
Khakra	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Leaves are used in marriage as a platter (pattal)</li></ul>
Tendupatta	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Leaves of this tree are used for making the Bidi (roll of leaf containing tobacco)</li></ul>
Bamboo	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Bamboos are used in boundary/ fencing around the field/house for security</li><li>• Use in construction of houses and decoration purpose</li><li>• Also used for medicinal purpose</li></ul>
Neem	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Leaf is used as a medicine for security from peats at the time of storage of wheat</li><li>• Tender twigs are used as toothbrush.</li></ul>
