

Agriculture

Dayalbagh community is involved in extensive agriculture practices. Community maintains around 1200 acres of cultivable land and is involved in cultivation of major crops of rabbi, khareef and jaid. Agriculture production includes production of crops like Rice, wheat, dal (masoor dal, urad dal, moong dal, chane), vegetables, fruits, sugarcane etc.

In spite of various technological adoptions Dayalbagh works on the basis of human labour model in fields. These tools are generally used for few activities and rest maximum work is done by community members. Dayalbagh works on semi-mechanized model and encourages human labour (shramdan) in fields in order to maintain essence of human effort and also to make members physically active. All the members work together in the farms which increases the cooperative functioning and mutual understanding among members.
